# Judge

## **Ken Auster**

While working on his Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Long Beach State University, Ken built one of the world's most prominent silkscreen and T-shirt companies, creating now legendary surfing art.

In the mid 1990's Ken moved to a more serious art level, moving to oils and plein air. Ken describes himself as a painter of his surroundings that communicates and documents the reality of our times, the edge between nature and man-made, the vitality of the city and everyday occurrences that we take for granted.

In a relatively short time Ken moved to the forefront of American contemporary impressionists. He consistently walks away with gold medals and first place awards at juried exhibits. His work has been in museum exhibits at the Haggin Museum in Stockton, Colorado History Museum in Denver, Laguna Art Museum in Laguna Beach, the Bakersfield Museum in Bakersfield, Orange County Museum of Art in Newport Beach, and the Texas Museum of Art in Corpus Christi. He has been featured in magazines such as Art & Antiques, and Southwest Art. Articles have also appeared in Art Talk, Los Angeles Times, Surfers Journal, and The Orange County Register. His work is collected by galleries, corporations and patrons worldwide.

Ken Auster is a signature member of the Plein Air Painters of America, a founding member of Laguna Plein Air Painters Association, and a signature member of the California Art Club.

# What is Plein Air?

*Plein Air* refers to a style of painting that became popular in the mid-19th century and was advocated by the French impressionists such as Claude Monet and Pierre-Auguste Renoir. Plein Air painting is done outdoors in one sitting and the subject is the scene before the artist. The invention of tube paint and the box easel that carries paints and brushes and folds to be easily transported, led to the popularity of this art form.

## Why in Carmel?

Frank Hubbard Powers, a San Francisco attorney and his wife Jane Gallatin Powers, an artist, were two of the founders of Carmel along with James Frank Devendorf.

By 1901 they had bought up more than three fourths of what is now Carmel-by-the-Sea. She was the first Plein Air painter here, as well as a studio painter, and she was a strong advocate for the arts. Jane and Frank convinced many of their artist friends left homeless by the 1906 San Francisco earthquake to move to Carmel.

By 1910 the *San Francisco Call* reported that 60% of Carmel's houses were built by citizens who were devoting their lives to work connected to the aesthetic arts. We are proud to have one of Jane Powers great-great-grandchildren as a frequent participant in our Plein Air competition.


